FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

"To everything, turn, turn, turn. There is a season, turn, turn, turn. And a purpose under Heaven."

The Byrds were founded in 1964 and underwent many changes to their lineup over the years, with names we might recognize like Gram Parsons and David Crosby, who passed away in January of this year. While Jim McGuinn might not be as recognizable a name as those two now, he was the Byrd instrumental in composing this song, "Turn! Turn!" in 1965, one of the few that many of us would recognize from Ecclesiastes 3:1-8. Originally adapted from the verses in Ecclesiastes by folk singer Pete Seeger in 1959, these words have undergone changes themselves over the years.

"To everything there is a season, a time for every purpose under heaven. A time to be born, and a time to die, a time to plant, And a time to pluck what is planted;...A time to love, and a time to hate; A time of war, and a time of peace." vs. 1-2, 8 NKJV

When you receive this we will be officially in the season of Spring. Despite mountains of snow, despite fears of flooding or heavy snow breaking roofs or gutters or roads, we will have officially turned over a new leaf and landed in Spring. In the church calendar we will either be fast approaching Holy Week, still the 4th season, or we will be in the 5th season of Easter. Or maybe you'll pick it up later in the last season of the church calendar of Pentecost. This year or the next...the promises of our faith remain for all seasons to bring light—with or without Daylight savings time.

Whatever season you are in in your life, in whatever season you read these words, may you be touched by the story of the Resurrection of Easter life. May you be empowered, moved, pushed, surrounded by the Holy Spirit held in the promises of Hope, Love, and new life. Wanna talk about it? Call a friend or even acquaintance. One of the promises of the Easter season is that we will not be left alone, Jesus said. The Advocate, the Holy Spirit is present, a cup of coffee shared, an admonition of correction lovingly shared, a celebration of family gathered.
