FROM THE DESK OF PASTOR DEB STAVE

We all missed Ash Wednesday in different ways in both of our congregations Bethany and Mayville UCC. That yearly cross of Ashes put on our foreheads
and hearing the words, "Remember you are dust and to dust you will return,"
welcoming us to the cross walk of grace and renewal.

Many of you already heard me say I was pleasantly surprised the week before Lent started when I reminded the Bethany confirmands that we would not be having ashes because of the concern for safe distancing and touch due to covid precautions. Some of them declared "But I (we) really like that part!". Seeing that black cross on each other's forehead so easily identifying for and to each other that we belong to a faith family. That visible Black cross connecting us back to the cross made on our foreheads at baptism.

We did have that opportunity for ash-cross foreheads last year and then shortly thereafter closed up church gatherings for several months. A whole year we have lived with routines both in our worship lives and in most every other aspect of day to day living being cancelled, limited, or altered daily. And here we are now - March will wind up Lent with Holy Week being the last Sunday - March 28th.

I've heard several of you say you've been able to visit (especially with family) a bit more, have felt lighter and hopeful as vaccinations are available, and are actually making new travel plans with family and friends.

I had always heard Lent could be translated as Spring. I heard an alternative from a Theology Prof this year saying it could be translated as "Lengthening". The days lengthening from winter darkness to spring sunshine. Daylight Savings begins March 14th. Spring Ahead..a little step backward where the dawn light will come earlier and we'll lose a little of the lengthening evening last light that we have now. Foreheads and hands anticipating dirt and dust for spring's work in fields and gardens. Lengthening sunshine, lengthening Sonlight as the seeds of the gifts we possess at whatever age we are in life's journey work to build up the family connections all over God's greening creation.

We may not see the black cross inviting us to grace and renewal but may we see the indelible baptismal cross on each other's face whoever we cross paths with. It is the

way of the Jesus family routine seeing the atonement from the cross calling us to follow the one who Calls us to "AT-ONE-MENT" (John 17-21) Grow in Grace dear family.
