Council felt it was appropriate to have both churches contribute their 3rd quarter dollars and we can see where we are at later in the year. Fifth Sunday joint services were discussed again. A joint Rockin' R Ranch service will be scheduled for Sunday, August 29th at 10:30AM followed by a potluck lunch. Next meeting was set for Wednesday, October 20th at 6:00PM at Bethany Church.
