FROM THE DESK OF PASTOR DEB STAVE

Old Normal? New Normal? When will there be a normal routine and rhythm?

Often bible verses go floating through my mind - sometimes I have to get out my unabridged concordance to find the book, chapter and verse, sometimes it works to use a search engine but usually I can find what I'm thinking of after a while.

I often ask folks if they have a favorite verse, or in some circumstances if they had a verse for confirmation they chose or was given them. Hebrews 13:8 - "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever." That one has been on a continuous loop in my head the week I'm writing this. It was the confirmation verse of a septuagint World War II vet that held his confirmation verse in his heart despite not finding the established church to be his community. When I asked what that meant to him he said God is God and Jesus never changes. God is Good, God is great. God is God...

We have had the gift of meeting in person and being the church together for a little while now when some still are not gathering except through the air waves. Outside some meet or safely as they can meet inside being the church together. As the weather gets colder and the roads maybe more challenging, we are church together in a building or in Spirit. We are asked to pick up our cross and follow - to be all we are meant to be. Those gifts are differing, some well honed, some growing into them but our gifts together let the world know the church is never closed. The church is us and we got a story to tell. So the new normal may not come for a while. But there is one thing I know..the Holy Spirit will give us the words to pray, that nothing will separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus. And in Christ we can agree to disagree and use what we have to let God still speak. If those things sound familiar they're from Romans chapter 8 that we went through this summer. Chapter 8 - pretty much all of it, is worth saying/reading a few or a hundred times so no matter what, you'll know it in your insides even if you forget everything else. Prayer and relationship that is certain...in a God who came in flesh and blood, fully human, fully God to show us what it is to be humane and beloved of God. Thank God, Jesus is the Messiah and we get to be the ones to follow. Grace, growth, forgiveness and the abundant life to you All.
